Coach Heinz is in her seventh season as head coach of the Lady Eagle soccer program. Coach Heinz was named the Big South Conference Coach of the Year in 2006. In 1999, Heinz was named Coach of the Year in the Gulf Coast Conference and NAIA Region XIII. She spent the 2000 season as head coach at Huntingdon College in Montgomery, AL, and served three years at the helm of the William Carey College program in Gulfport, MS. Under her direction, Huntingdon won the 2000 Small College National Championship. She led William Carey College to its first ever appearance at the NAIA National tournament. Heinz is certified and licensed as a USSF “B” coach. Heinz was named NCAA Division I Coach of the Year for 1st year programs by Soccer Buzz magazine.

Coach Brabson is in his 3rd season as asst. coach of the Lady Eagle soccer program. Prior to becoming an Eagle he was the Head Coach at Queens University of Charlotte for 5 seasons. Coach Brabson is a graduate of Maryville College, where he was a team captain and NSCAA All-Region performer. He also spent 2 seasons playing professionally. Coach Brabson holds an USSF “D” license, an NSCAA National and an NSCAA Advanced National Diploma.
